1 Introduction

2 Linux

To get started with WebDAV editing under linux you need to install a WebDAV client such as [cadaver](http://www.webdav.org/cadaver/) (<http://www.webdav.org/cadaver/>) .

2.1 Cadaver - command line

Most distributions offer a packaged version of [cadaver](http://www.webdav.org/cadaver/) (<http://www.webdav.org/cadaver/>) .

After having cadaver installed open a shell of your choice and type the following

```
cadaver http://localhost:8888/default/webdav
```

You will be asked for your username and password:

```
Username: lenya  
Password: levi
```

Optional (if you do not like "vi") you can change the default editor:

```
dav:/default/webdav/> set editor emacs
```

Now you can edit and save your first file via webdav.

```
dav:/default/webdav/> edit tutorial_en.html
```
