Major changes: we're listening

New Sun Contributor Agreement (SCA) replaced former Joint Contributor Agreement (JCA)

LGPLv3 replaced former LGPLv2 license

Great new website look & feel, including 1-click download

Improved tools: migration to Subversion is done. A distributed system being the next step.



Community Innovation Award

Downloads:

- >2.5 million a week on average (compared to about 1m/week a year ago)
- First week after Ooo3.0 launch >3m downloads
- New MAC version in high demand

Around 70% of submitted patches fixed and integrated

Quality: 10.000+ bug fixes between 2.0 and 3.0


