

Definitions:

- •WAL Directory: The HDFS directory named for a given tablet server, in which it stores its logs.
- •Tablet Reference: A WAL entry in the !METADATA table.

States:

- •Open: The WAL file exists in the WAL Directory.
- •In Use: The WAL file exists in the WAL Directory and at least one Tablet Reference exists.
- •Full: The WAL file exists in the WAL Directory, at least one Tablet Reference exists, and the WAL file is read-only.
- •Full Unreferenced: The WAL file exists in the WAL Directory, there are no Tablet References, and the WAL file is read-only.
- •Clean: The WAL file has been removed from HDFS and no Tablet References exist.
- •Failed Unreferenced: The tablet server that created the WAL file has no lock in zookeeper, the WAL file exists in the WAL Directory, and no Tablet References exist.
- •Failed Referenced: The tablet server that created the WAL file has no lock in zookeeper, the WAL file exists in the WAL Directory, and at least one Tablet Reference exists.
- •Recovery: The WAL file is somewhere in the process of being recovered.
