1. Subversion

WSRP4J now uses Subversion for source control. The latest code is available at

```
https://svn.apache.org/repos/asf/portals/wsrp4j/trunk
```

You can check out the latest code using command line Subversion like this:

```
svn co https://svn.apache.org/repos/asf/portals/wsrp4j/trunk
```

2. Read-only, locked, legacy CVS

As of 28 October 2005, the cvs has been locked and has only read access from now on. Use SVN to access the latest code.

Anyone can checkout source code from our anonymous CVS server. To do so, simply use the following commands (if you are using a GUI CVS client, configure it appropriately):

```
cvcs -d :pserver:anoncvs@cvs.apache.org:/home/cvspublic login
password: anoncvs

cvcs -d :pserver:anoncvs@cvs.apache.org:/home/cvspublic checkout
ws-wsrp4j
```
